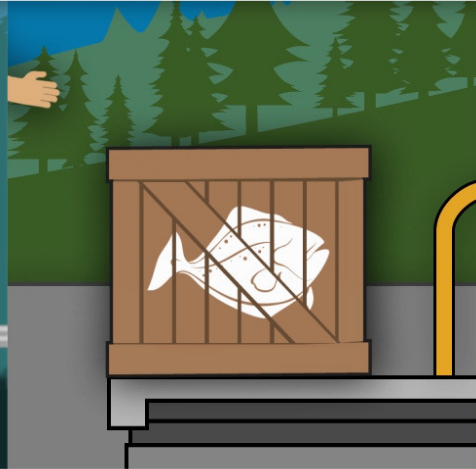

# A message from the Executive Director

Dear Friends,

I am proud to report that SeaShare maintained a strong position in 2018. Our seafood donations went to thirty three locations in nineteen states, with a total of over 1.45 million pounds of seafood going to some of the 40 million Americans who still struggle with hunger.

We saw new partnerships develop in Bethel, Alaska with the installation of a freezer container donated by Matson, and supported by the Rasmuson Foundation, the Terry Shaff Fund, and many others. We are excited to add Bethel to our growing network of communities in Alaska with reliable and year round cold storage for seafood donations.

The allergy-friendly seafood start-up Hook Line & Savor hit grocery store shelves, and we are thrilled that supporting SeaShare and hunger relief is a core component of their new retail line.

This year, SeaShare will celebrate 25 years of bringing the highest quality seafood to food banks and feeding centers. We are so thankful for all of our partners who've made this work possible; though we are saddened that despite major economic growth in recent years, the proportion of Americans who don't have enough food to eat remains higher than before the great recession.

We will continue to partner with Feeding America to serve the people who rely on food banks to get enough to eat. I think you agree, *everyone* deserves access to nutritious seafood.

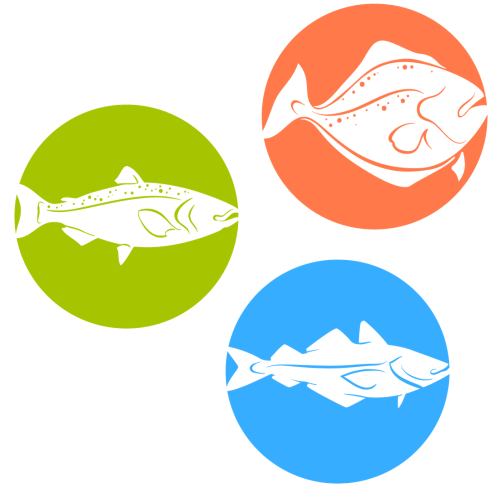

# Program Highlights

SeaShare partnered with the **National Fisheries Institute's** Future Leaders program to sort food donations in Miami in January, and to raise funds for hunger relief in the fall. In total, \$9,325 was raised by the Future Leaders class, with 600 pounds of seafood donated. Thank you, Future Leaders!

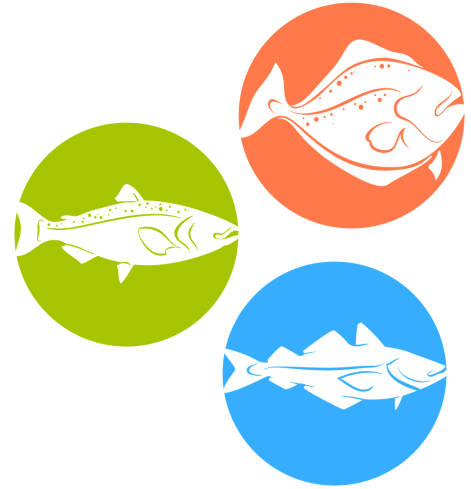
**Our programs in Alaska continued to grow.** We installed a new freezer container in Bethel, and continued to work with community partners in Dillingham to distribute seafood from our freezer there. We also sent 19,000 pounds of seafood to Nome and Kotzebue with support from the US Coast Guard in Kodiak.



# Program Highlights

SeaShare was honored to be selected as a finalist for the **SeaWeb Seafood Champion Award** in Leadership. Nearly 100 nominations were submitted, and SeaShare was selected as one of 17 finalists in four categories: leadership, innovation, vision, and advocacy.

SeaShare entered into a strategic partnership with **Hook Line and Savor**, a new seafood start-up. Hook Line and Savor is a retail line that brings delicious allergy friendly seafood to dinner tables across the U.S., and they have pledged to donate 5% of all profits to fight hunger through SeaShare.

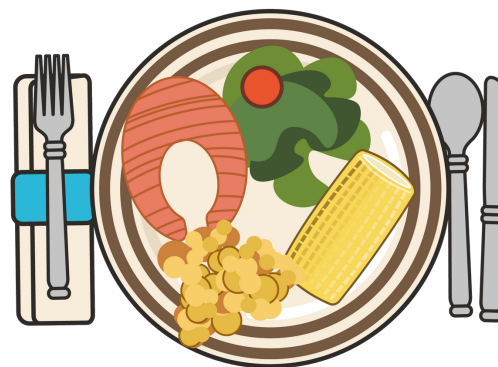

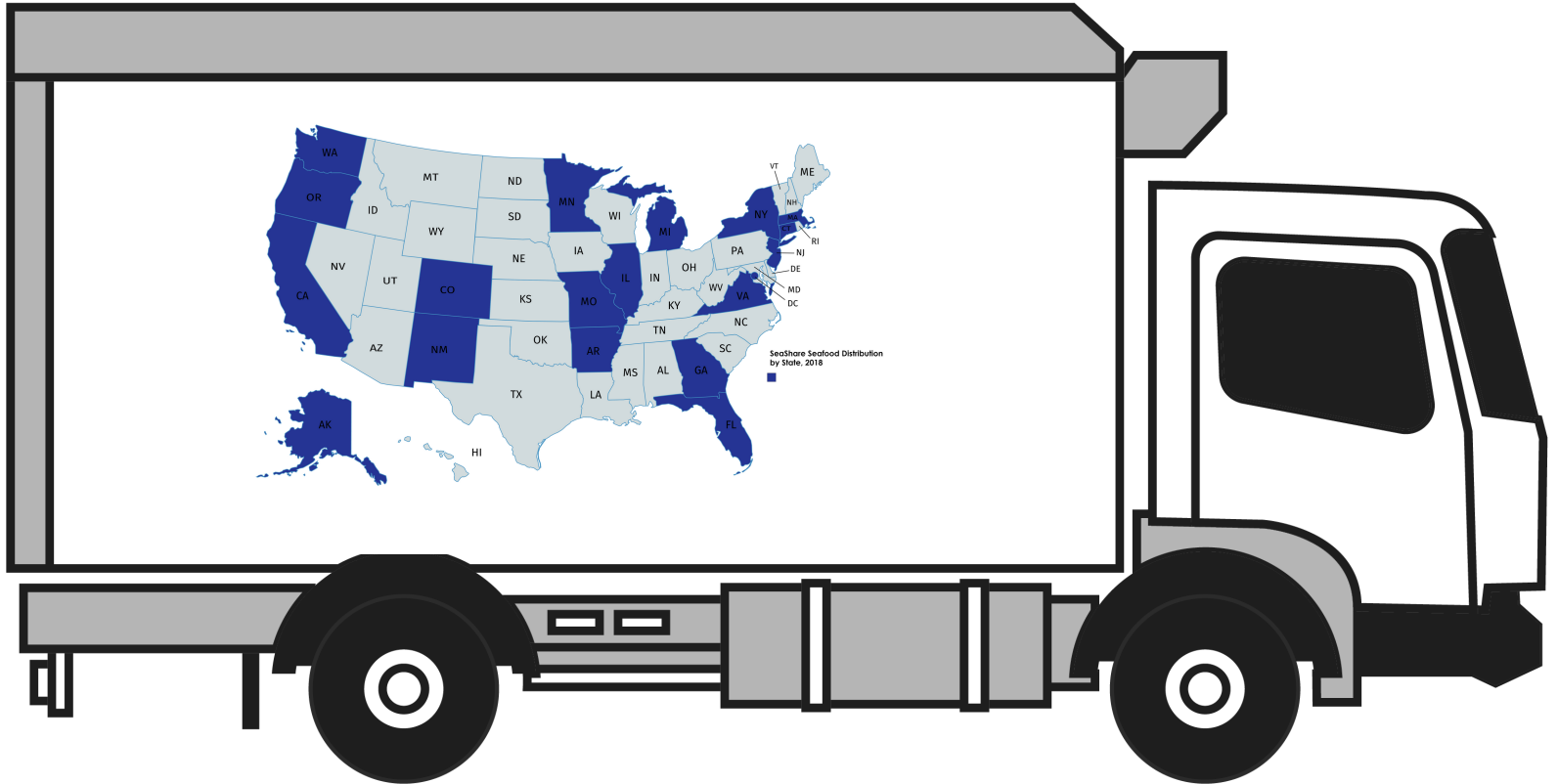

Total pounds distributed in 2018: 1,450,695

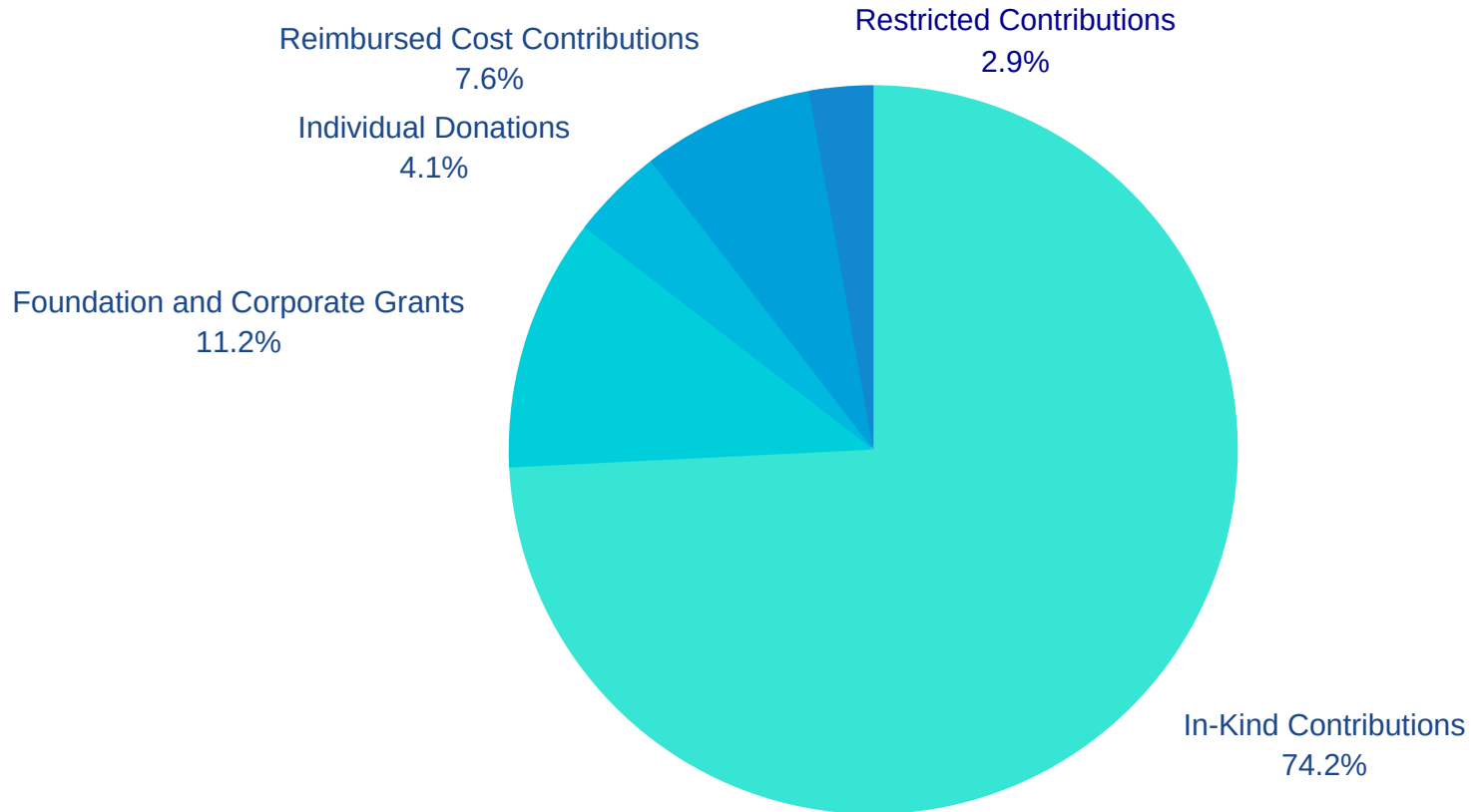

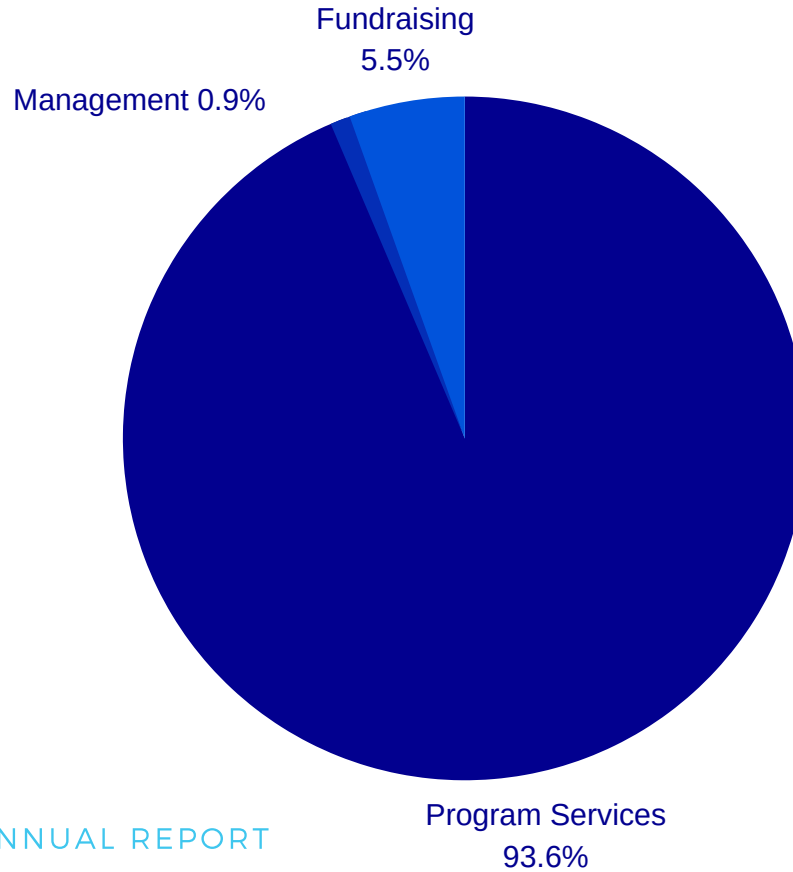
